National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutant Worksheet

Businesses that are subject to a NSPS or a NESHAP are not eligible for the small source exemption. Please review the following NESHAP standards to determine if you may be subject to a standard before completing question 7 in section II of the Small Source Registration Notice. This is only a partial list of standards that may apply. Check the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, Part 63 for a complete list.

Subpart M	Commercial Dry Cleaning (Perchloroethylene) Dry-to-dry and transfer machines	No minimums; "Existing"-installed before 12/9/91; "New"-on or after 12/9/91; Final 9/22/93
Subpart O	Commercial Sterilization Facilities (Ethylene Oxide)	>1 ton per year; Final 12/6/94
Subpart N	Chromium Electroplating and Anodizing	No minimums; Final 1/25/95
Subpart T	Halogenated Solvents Cleaning	Non-halogenated solvents containing <5% halogenated solvents by weight; Final 12/2/94
Subpart JJ	Wood Furniture Manufacturing	Sources using <250 gal/month, or 3,000 gal per rolling 12 month period, of coating, gluing, cleaning, and washoff materials. Record keeping required; Final 12/7/95

¹Applicability refers to the minimum size of the equipment or process to which the standard applies. Effective dates refers to when the rule was promulgated (put into effect).
